# AGENDA ITEM 3 - Annual Report 2002

#### 1) Introduction

At the beginning of January 2002, the Association's membership stood at 57 members (31 Full members, 25 Associate members and 1 Individual member).

By the third quarter of the academic year, the following applications were received:

# 2) AAOU 2002 Annual Conference

Korea National Open University successfully held the AAOU 2002 Annual Conference between 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2002, in Seoul, Korea. More than 350 delegates from eighteen countries were in attendance. The President of KNOU, the Deputy Prime Minister, and the Minister of Education & Human Resources Development of Korea conducted the Opening Ceremony. The AAOU Award of Meritorious Service for the year 2002 was awarded to Prof. S W Tam, President of OUHK and former President of AAOU, for his lifelong contributions to open and distance education in Hong Kong as well as the Asian region.

Professor Michael G. Moore delivered the conference keynote address and the title was 'Distance Education and Lifelong Learning in the Digital Age'. In keeping with the improving standard of AAOU conferences, there were numerous quality presentations. The best paper prize was awarded to Dr. Yvonne Fung & Thomas Tang, Open University of Hong Kong for their paper entitled: A Comparison of Two Learning Communities in the Digital Era:

How Contexts and Functions Affect Online Participation in Distance Learning Courses for Teachers.

Two pre-conference workshops were also held:

- The workshop A was organized by Dr. Namin, Shin and the title was 'Research questions in ODL: what and how have they been addressed?'.
- The workshop B was organized by Dr. Yeong-Mahn, You and the title was 'JIT (just-in-time) e-learning and knowledge objects'.
